Executive Summary

Operational maturity becomes a competitive advantage.



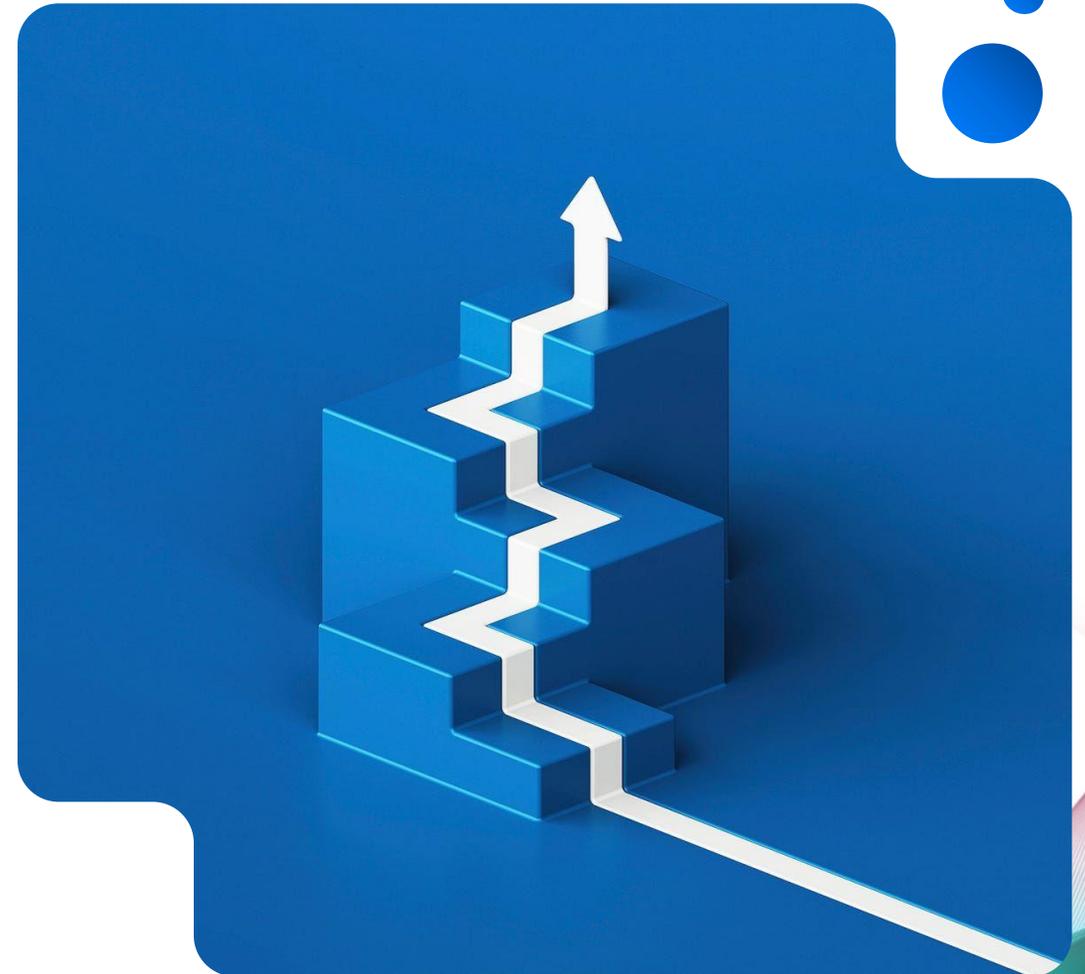
